CMS Requirements for Long Term Care Facilities

42 C.F.R. §483.73 - EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

- (m) Disaster and emergency preparedness. (1) The facility must have detailed written plans and procedures to meet all potential emergencies and disasters, such as fire, severe weather, and missing residents.
- (2) The facility <u>must train all employees in emergency procedures when</u> <u>they begin to work in the facility</u>, periodically review the procedures with existing staff, and carry out unannounced staff drills using those procedures.

Title

• Workers in hospitals, nursing homes, and other healthcare settings face risks of workplace violence. Many factors contribute to this risk, including working directly with people who have a history of aggressive behavior, behavioral issues, or may be under the influence of drugs. • An April 2020 Bureau of Labor Statistics Fact Sheet found that healthcare workers accounted for 73 percent of all nonfatal workplace injuries and illnesses due to violence in 2018. This number has been steadily growing since tracking of these specific events began in 2011. • Exposure to workplace violence hazards come at a high cost; however, with appropriate controls in place, it can be addressed. • CMS will continue to enforce the regulatory expectations that patient and staff have an environment that prioritizes their safety to ensure effective delivery of healthcare.





Tennessee Regulatory Provisions – NH Rules

1200-08-06-.14 DISASTER PREPAREDNESS.

(2) (a) 1. Every nursing home shall have a current internal emergency plan, or plans, that provides for fires, bomb threats, severe weather, utility service failures, plus any local high risk situations such as floods, earthquakes, toxic fumes and chemical spills. The plan should consider the probability of the types of disasters which might occur, both natural and "man-made."

(2) (c) 1. All nursing homes shall establish and maintain communications with the county Emergency Management Agency.





Tennessee Regulatory Provisions – ACLF Rules

1200-08-25-.16 DISASTER PREPAREDNESS.

- (1) An ACLF shall have in effect and available for all supervisory personnel and staff written copies of the following disaster, refuge and/or evacuation plans readily available at all times:
- (a) Fire Safety Procedures Plan...
- (b) Tornado/Severe Weather Procedures Plan...
- (c) Bomb Threat Procedures Plan...
- (d) Flood Procedure Plan...
- (e) Severe Cold Weather and Severe Hot Weather Procedure Plans...
- (f) Earthquake Disaster Procedures Plan...
- (3) An ACLF shall participate in the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency local/county emergency plan on an annual basis.
